- 1. Cover up.** Yes, it's hot out. But cover your child in a sunscreen with at least 15 SPF (sun protection factor) that protects against UVA and UVB rays.
- 2. Play safe.** Do this quick playground safety check: The safety-tested mats or loose-fill (like sand or wood chips) should be at least nine inches deep.
- 3. Don't bug out!** To avoid ticks, tuck in loose clothing when hiking. Make tick-checks a routine when you're coming in from outdoors.
- 4. Keep water handy.** Kids should drink four to six ounces of water every 15 minutes before, during and after exercise to stay hydrated.
- 5. It's good to be hardheaded!** Kids who bike should be wearing helmets. Helmets should have the Consumer Product Safety Commission (CPSC) seal of approval.

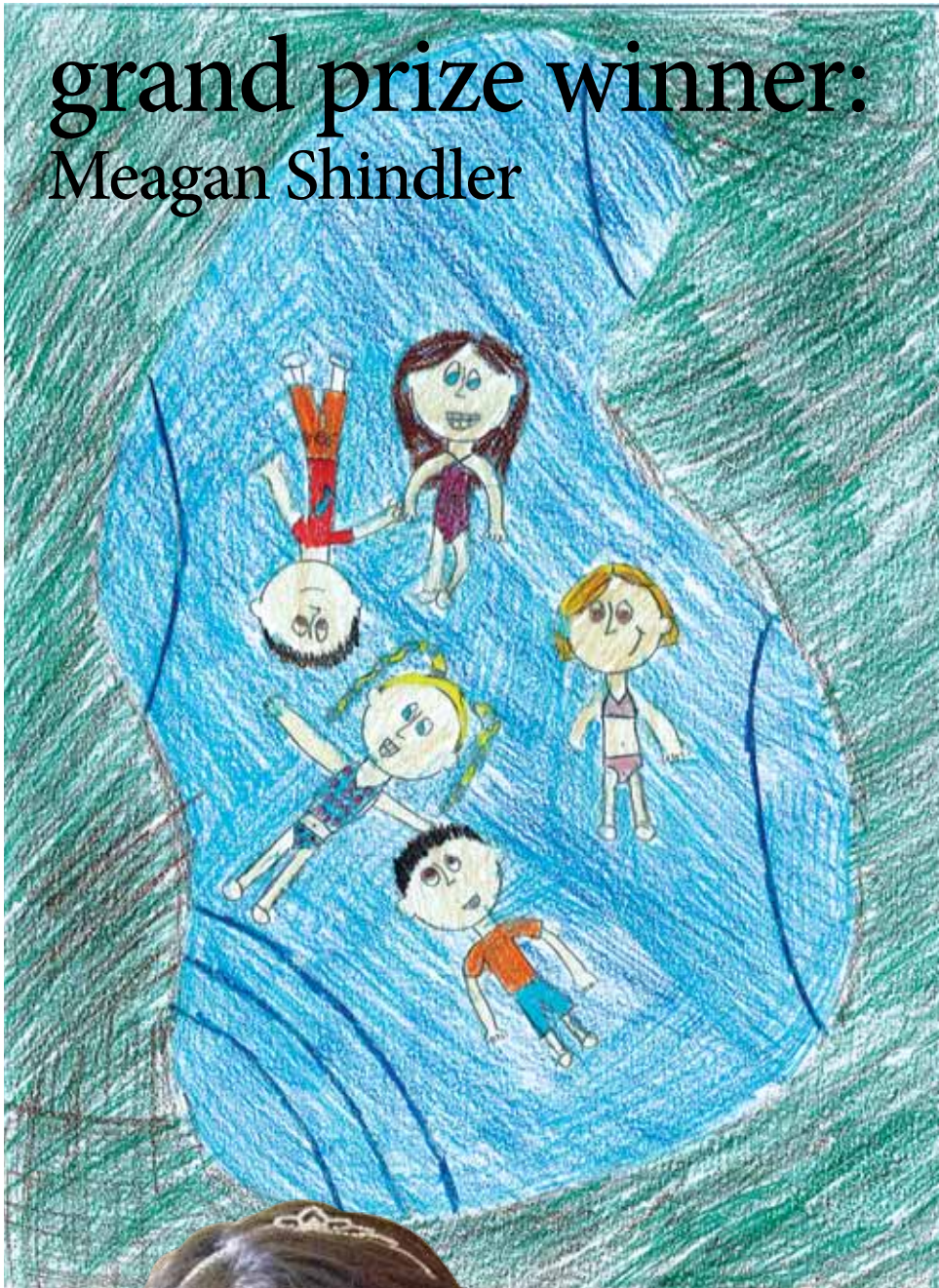

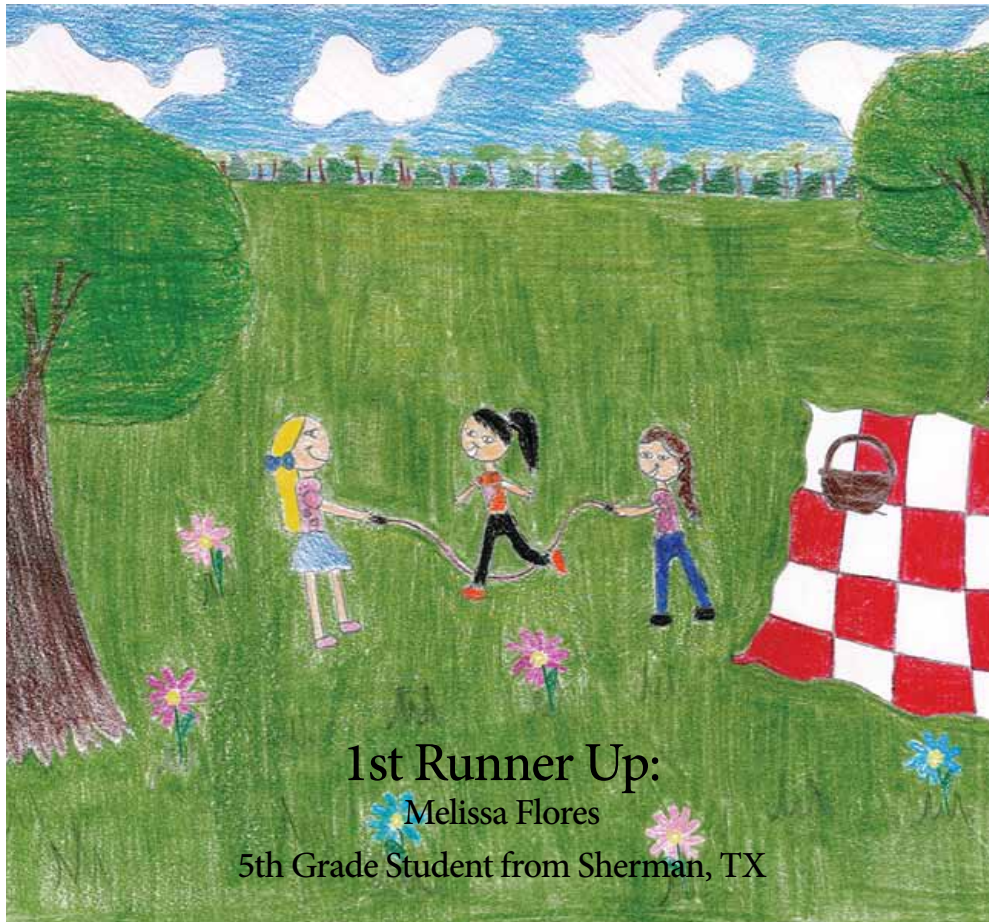
